SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
2. LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDERS. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30.00 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES. 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.
3. **MANAGEMENT** reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to, the show, without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Management.
4. **ALL ENTRIES** are accepted with the understanding that the Santa Barbara National Amateur Horse Show will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of Management but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Santa Barbara National Amateur Horse Show against any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.
5. **ALL OWNERS AND EXHIBITORS** with entries will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the Showgrounds and will be billed accordingly.
6. **ENTRIES** of persons suspended or expelled from the USEF, Management may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude towards a Recognized competition or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a Recognized competition or to its management.

7. **MANAGEMENT** reserves the right to cancel, consolidate, or split classes depending upon entries received at closing date.
8. **MANAGEMENT** reserves the privilege of substituting or changing judges if it becomes necessary. The Judge's decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and Management accepts no responsibility for these decisions.
9. **PROTESTS.** Please refer to GR 603 for complete rule.
10. **ENTRIES CLOSE AND MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2009. ORIGINAL ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER CLOSING DATE WILL BE ASSESSED A POST ENTRY FEE OF \$15.00 PER HORSE, UNLESS ORIGINAL ENTRY IS MADE AT THE SHOW, IN WHICH CASE THE POST ENTRY FEE PER HORSE SHALL BE \$25.00. NO ENTRIES, SUBSTITUTIONS OR CLASS CHANGES WILL BE TAKEN OVER THE TELEPHONE OR BY FAX.**
11. **CHANGES.** Care should be taken to enter animal in its proper class. Exhibitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents in making out entry blanks. Any changes will be charged the rate of \$5.00 per class.
12. **ADDS AND SCRATCHES: Adds may be made at no extra charge until 4 PM on the day before the start of the show. Scratches will receive full credit providing they are scratched by 4 PM on Tuesday, November 24. After 4 PM on Tuesday, November 24, a penalty of \$5.00 per class will be charged for added classes. If classes are scratched after the start of the show a full refund, less a \$5.00 per class scratched fee will be given. An open, signed check must be on file with the show secretary to cover these additional fees and other incidentals. Credit card payment may be substituted for the open check in the horse show office.**
13. **R.D.N.E. FEE.** Any horse or rider showing in a class that they did not enter will be charged a \$10.00 *Rode-Did-Not-Enter* penalty, plus the late fee and class entry fee.
14. **ENTRIES MADE LATER THAN ONE HOUR AFTER THE END OF THE SHOW ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 28TH FOR THE SUNDAY CLASSES, WILL BE CHARGED A DOUBLE ENTRY FEE.**
15. **REFUNDS.** Full refunds, will be given if written notice is received by the Show Secretary before the closing of entries. Exhibitors cancelling their entries for any reason after the official closing date shall forfeit all entry, stall and association fees, UNLESS a valid Veterinarian's or Doctor's certificate of disability for entered horse/rider is submitted to the Horse Show Secretary prior to the first event of the Horse Show. A \$25 fee will be assessed on all refunds. If illness or injury after the start of the show should prevent exhibitor's participation in the balance of entered classes, a refund of unused class fees will be made, less a \$25 office fee, providing the balance of classes are officially scratched and a doctor's certificate is provided within 48 hours of the close of the show. Stall and association fees will not be refunded.
16. **PENALTY.** There will be a penalty of \$50.00 if a check is refused by the bank for any reason. No checks will be processed through the bank a second time, and must be covered by a money order, credit card, cashier's check, or cash, in addition to the penalty and bank charges.

17. **NUMBERS.** No competition numbers will be released by the Horse Show Secretary until all entry blanks are complete, all necessary credentials have been seen, payment in full has been received, and an open check is on file with the Horse Show Secretary.
18. **STABLING.** All stalls are approximately 10' x 10', of wood construction, with top and bottom doors. Stalls are **\$130.00**. No first bedding will be furnished. Horses may **arrive after noon on Monday, November 23rd**.
19. **FEED AND BEDDING.** NO FIRST BEDDING WILL BE PROVIDED. STRAW OR SHAVINGS MAY BE USED. To order arrival bedding and feed, please call ahead to **La Cumbre Feed at (805) 687-1880**.
20. **FOOTING.** Footing in all competition arenas is a combination of sand, dirt, shavings and inorganic material. All arenas are 125' by 250'.
21. **DOGS AND ALL OTHER PETS** must be on leashes at all times. Stray animals will be impounded and removed from the grounds. A \$25.00 impounding fee will be charged and enforced.
22. **JUMPING ORDERS AND JUMPER CLASS CONFLICTS.** A rotating jumping order will be established for all jumping classes. All horses must be ridden in posted order. Riders who have conflicts must arrange their jumping orders with the Paddock Stewards. Management will disqualify any contestant who does not cooperate in this matter.
23. **IN CASE OF TIES FOR SHOW CHAMPIONSHIPS, TIES WILL BE BROKEN IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:**
 - 1) **Most points over fences**
 - 2) **Highest placing in the Championship****In case of exact ties after the above are considered, duplicate awards will be given.**
24. **ALL RIDERS** riding in Hunter, Jumper, and Hunter Seat Equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitting protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.
25. **PARKING.** Fire regulations prohibit exhibitor vehicles including cars, trailers, vans and campers from being parked in barn areas. Designated parking will be posted. There will be no exceptions and violators will be towed away at owner's expense.

26. **MOPEDS, SCOOTERS & A.T.V.'s:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
27. **OFFICIAL MEASURING.** The official veterinarian will be available to conduct measurements from 7am-8am on Wednesday, November 25.

The single team entry fee, per horse, entitles the team horses to compete in all eligible jumping classes as a team, with points counted accordingly, making it possible for a horse to be both an individual champion and a team champion.
- Ø Each team is to carry a name or wear appropriate clothing to go with a team name. If one rider/horse drops out of a two member team, that team may continue with only one horse / rider.
- Ø No substitutions or additions may be made after the start of the first jumping class of each age group. Blue ribbons will be awarded to the first place team after each class. The winning team will be presented with a sash for each member to be worn in the next class, to distinguish that they were the winners in the previous class.
- Ø The sashes are different colors for each day and are to be kept by the winners.
 - Ø Wednesday – Green Sash
 - Thursday – Pink Sash
 - Friday – White Sash
 - Saturday – Yellow Sash
 - Sunday – Red Sash
 - Overall team winners – Blue Sash
- Ø Teams entered must show in all classes of their age groups to determine the high point winner in their age group. In computing points for class winners and high point champion teams, ribbons won will count as follows: 1st – 10 points; 2nd – 6 points; 3rd – 4 points; 4th – 2 points; 5th – 1 point, 6th – ½ point.
- Ø In ties not involving first place in all classes, riders of horses will toss a coin for ribbons, but the highest place points of the tie will be given to all horses involved in the flip.
