## SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **MANAGEMENT** reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to, the show, without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Management.
2. **ALL ENTRIES** are accepted with the understanding that the Santa Barbara National Western Horse Show will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of Management but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Santa Barbara National Western Horse Show against any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.
3. **ALL OWNERS AND EXHIBITORS** with entries will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the Showgrounds and will be billed accordingly.
4. **MANAGEMENT** may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude towards the competition or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at the competition or to its management.
5. **MANAGEMENT** reserves the right to cancel, consolidate, or split classes depending upon entries received at closing date.
6. **MANAGEMENT** reserves the privilege of substituting or changing judges if it becomes necessary. The Judge's decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and Management accepts no responsibility for these decisions.
7. **PROTESTS.** Any exhibitor lodging a protest must first deposit \$200.00 with the Show Secretary, which sum shall be forfeited to the Horse Show if same is not sustained. All protests must be in writing, signed by the protester, and filed with the Show Secretary within **48** hours of the occurrence of the alleged violation. In case the protest is sustained, the entries standing next in awards will be moved up accordingly.
8. **ENTRIES CLOSE AND MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2006. ORIGINAL ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER CLOSING DATE WILL BE ASSESSED A POST ENTRY FEE OF \$15.00 PER HORSE, UNLESS ORIGINAL ENTRY IS MADE AT THE SHOW, IN WHICH CASE THE POST ENTRY FEE PER HORSE SHALL BE \$25.00. NO ENTRIES, SUBSTITUTIONS OR CLASS CHANGES WILL BE TAKEN OVER THE TELEPHONE OR FAX AND A HORSE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED ENTERED UNTIL ITS ENTRY FORM IS SUBMITTED WITH BOTH THE HORSE AND CLASSES ENTERED.**
9. **ADDS AND SCRATCHES:** Adds may be made at no extra charge until 4 PM Thursday, Nov. 16. Scratches will receive full credit providing they are scratched by 4 PM on Thursday, Nov. 16. After 4 PM on Thursday, Nov. 16, a penalty of \$5.00 per class will be charged for added classes. If classes are scratched after Thursday, Nov. 16, a full refund, less a \$5.00 per class scratch fee, will be given. An open, signed check must be on file with the show secretary to cover these additional fees and other incidentals. Credit card payment may be substituted for the open check in the horse show office.

10. **R.D.N.E. FEE.** Any horse or rider showing in a class they did not enter will be charged a \$10.00 *Rode-Did-Not-Enter* penalty, plus the late fee and class entry fee.
11. **ALL OWNERS, TRAINERS AND RIDERS MUST SEND COPIES OF THEIR CURRENT PCHA CARDS WITH THEIR ENTRIES. IF COPIES ARE NOT INCLUDED WITH THE ORIGINAL ENTRY, A \$5.00 PCHA NON-MEMBER FEE WILL BE CHARGED.**
12. **ANYONE WHO EXHIBITS AS AN AMATEUR** must be in possession of a USEF Amateur card or an Amateur Card from any other nationally recognized breed association or a NRHA Non-Pro card.
13. **ENTRIES MADE LATER THAN 1 HOUR AFTER THE END OF SHOW ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 18, FOR THE SUNDAY CLASSES, WILL BE CHARGED A DOUBLE ENTRY FEE.**
14. **REFUNDS.** Full refunds, less a \$25 office charge will be given if written notice is received by the Show Secretary before the closing of entries. Exhibitors cancelling their entries for any reason after the official closing date shall forfeit all entry and association fees, UNLESS a valid Veterinarian's or Doctor's certificate of disability for entered horse/rider is submitted to the Horse Show Secretary prior to the first event of the Horse Show. A \$25 fee will be assessed on all refunds.
15. **PENALTY.** There will be a penalty of \$50.00 if a check is refused by the bank for any reason. No checks will be processed through the bank a second time, and must be covered by a money order, credit card, cashier's check, or cash, in addition to the penalty and bank charges.
16. **NUMBERS.** No competition numbers will be released by the Horse Show Secretary until all entry blanks are complete, all necessary credentials have been seen, payment in full has been received, and an open check is on file with the Horse Show Secretary.
17. **STABLING.** All stalls are approximately 10' x 10', of wood construction, with top and bottom doors. Stalls are **\$85.00**. No first bedding will be furnished. Horses may **arrive after 8:00 AM on Wednesday, November 15** and must **leave by noon on Monday, November 20**.
18. **FEED AND BEDDING.** NO FIRST BEDDING WILL BE PROVIDED. STRAW OR SHAVINGS MAY BE USED. To order arrival bedding and feed, please call ahead to **La Cumbre Feed at (805) 687-1880**. **Feed and bedding bills to be paid through the Horse Show Office**
19. **TRAINERS** wishing to split the cost of Tack Rooms, Feed Bills, etc. between their clients must fill in the proper forms, available in the horse show office no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the show.
20. **FOOTING.** Footing in all competition arenas is a combination of sand, dirt, shavings and inorganic material. All arenas are 125' by 250'.
21. **DOGS AND ALL OTHER PETS** must be on leashes at all times. Stray animals will be impounded and removed from the grounds. A \$25.00 impounding fee will be charged and enforced.
22. **Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid**

driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- 23. **PARKING.** Fire regulations prohibit exhibitor vehicles including cars, trailers, vans and campers from being parked in barn areas. Designated parking will be posted. There will be no exceptions and violators will be towed away at owner's expense.
- 24. **REFUNDS** will be mailed within 30 days following the last day of the show.
- 25. **RV AND CAMPER** space should be ordered on order form on page 7.
- 26. **OVERNIGHT PARKING – SLEEPING UNITS.** Anyone sleeping in ANY vehicle overnight must pay the permit fee and park in the RV lot unless otherwise arranged with the RV manager. Please see order form below.
