### YOUTH EXHIBIT GENERAL RULES:

- SB Fair and Expo is an open fair and therefore participants do not have to be a resident of Santa Barbara County to enter.
- All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form
- All entries must be delivered to the main exhibit building on assigned date and time. No late entries will be accepted.
- A participants may only enter 15 items per division, with the exception of "Table Settings" and "Group" entries.
- All entries must be prepared solely by the youth participant.
- All entries must be prepared within one year prior to the opening of the fair; April 2023-April 2024.
- Participant's name must clearly labeled be on the back or bottom of all entries.
- All entries will be scored on the Danish System. Entries will be judged based upon established standards of quality for each item. Each entry is judged according to how well It meets that standard rather than ho wit compares with other entries.
- Judging scoring guidelines:
  - o 1<sup>st</sup>, Superior, 92%-100%
  - o 1nd, Good, 84%-91%
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup>, Average, 70%-83%
- The SB Fair & Expo management shall not be responsible for accidents or losses that may occur to any of the participants or entries exhibited. The participants/ exhibitors shall hold the management harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accident or loss.
- All entries will follow additional "Division Rules: under specific Division heading in catalogue.
- Exhibitors must adhere to all SB fair rules.
